Grand Larceny Pursuit Ends in Arrest

Caroline County, Virginia - On January 13, 2021, at approximately 2:50 a.m. the Caroline County Communications Center received a 911 call regarding several, what appeared to be, male juveniles rummaging through unlocked vehicles in the Belmont subdivision. When Sgt. A. A. Lippa, III arrived on scene he observed three vehicles abruptly leave. One of the vehicles had just been stolen from the Belmont subdivision. When the deputies attempted to stop the vehicles, a pursuit ensued from Caroline, down Rt. 1, through Hanover, Ashland, and Henrico County.

The pursuit ended on Interstate 64 at the Staple Mills exit where the driver, a male juvenile, was taken into custody without incident after crashing at that location. It was later discovered that one of the other vehicles that eluded the deputies had also been reported stolen. That vehicle was later recovered in the City of Richmond after being involved in a hit and run crash.

The investigation is still ongoing.

Sheriff Lippa urges everyone to lock their vehicles and secure their personal belongings out of plain sight.
