Juvenile Involved Shooting Leads to Arrest

Caroline County, Virginia - On the evening of February 7, 2021, Caroline County Sheriff's Office deputies and investigators responded to a reported shooting in the Northwestern area of Caroline County. The investigation revealed that a 17 year-old juvenile sustained a non-life threatening gunshot wound to the leg. 18 year old Jaishaun Thomas, of Spotsylvania, has been charged in connection to this incident and is being held at the Pamunkey Regional Jail without bond. Thomas has been charged with aggravated malicious wounding, attempted armed robbery, use of a sawed-off shotgun in the perpetration of a crime of violence, and two counts of use of a firearm in the commission of a felony.

Sheriff Lippa stated, "For the public's reassurance, this incident was not a random act of violence and the victim and offender were known to each other. I am so proud of the men and women of the CCSO for making a quick arrest in this case."

No further details will be released at this time as this investigation is still ongoing.
